

Exeter May Meet 2010 - licence 2SW**** - Conditions of entry

1. The competition will be swum under A.S.A. Laws and Technical rules and licensed by the ASA for entry into National Competitions.
2. Age groups are: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16+ years. Ages on 9 May 2010.
3. All events will be run on a heat declared winner (HDW) basis. The last heat in each event will be spearheaded. **25m entry times should be submitted.**
4. All entries are subject to meeting the qualifying times. Entries may be restricted in order to keep the session times within appropriate time scales – the entry policy is **'first come, first served'**.
5. No time trials will be held.
6. Entries will be confirmed by email. Team managers will need to confirm any withdrawals, session by session, prior to the start of warm-up for the relevant session. No cards will be issued.
7. Awards will be given (in the age groups listed in Condition 2) to swimmers placed 1st to 3rd without disqualification for 100,200,400 events. Awards will be collectable from awards table, not presented.
8. Entry fee is £4.75 for 50m, 100m and 200m events and £6 for 400m. Entries must be made via email on the Hy-tek software only, available from the Exeter City website or by email from Ruth Stevens. Entries must be sent by a club with a **single club cheque**, not individual entries. Coach/team manager passes cost £12 which will entitle the holder to admission to all sessions, a programme and start sheets. Coach pass badges must be worn in conspicuously at all times.
9. All meet participants and spectators must observe all safety precautions in operation at The Pyramids and follow any instructions given by pool staff.
10. Swimmers must not go up to the spectator balcony without first drying off and putting on footwear and clothing before leaving the poolside.
11. **Competitors are advised not to leave their belongings unattended. Neither Exeter City Swimming club nor The Pyramids can accept responsibility for any property that may be lost or stolen.**
12. In accordance with the recommendations of the ASA child protection policy, any person wishing to use video, zoom or close range photography, including mobile phones that have photographic capabilities should first register their details at the spectator entrance. It is requested that all mobile phones are switched off or to silent during the competition and that there is no flash photography at the start of each event.
13. With the submission of entries, consent is deemed to have been given, as required of the Data Protection Act, to the holding and distribution as necessary, of personal information on computer, to run the meet.
14. The promoters reserve the right to alter the schedule if circumstances demand and, if necessary, restrict entries. **Closing date for entries is midnight on 9 April 2010.**
15. Please submit a summary sheet, HyTek entries report print-out, and a **single cheque covering all the entry fees and coach passes** made payable to 'Exeter City Swimming Club'.
